

**UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA CIVIL GATORS**  
**CIVIL ENGINEERING HALL OF FAME**  
**ELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Candidates will be graduates of the University of Florida Department of Civil and Coastal Engineering, or non-graduates that made significant contributions to the University and to the civil engineering profession in Florida.
2. Nominations may be made by any member of Civil Gators, including Civil Gators Board members. However, a current Board member may not be nominated.
3. The Civil Gators Board of Directors will consider all nominations on an annual basis, and may elect one or more candidates to the Hall of Fame. However, there will be no requirement for a minimum number of annual inductees.
4. Election to the Hall of Fame will result from a favorable vote of the majority of the Civil Gators Board of Directors.
5. Hall of Fame members may be living or deceased.
6. Consideration for the nomination/selection of candidates shall include at a minimum, one or more of the following criteria, as well as other criteria established by the Board from time to time:
  - Is a role model
  - Has enhanced the image of Civil Engineers through achievements in one or more of the following:
    - ◆ Education
    - ◆ Technical areas
    - ◆ Business
    - ◆ Public service
    - ◆ Professional associations
    - ◆ Community service
    - ◆ Enjoys a regional or statewide reputation
